**Motor Hackney Carriage (Newry) (Amendment) Bye-Laws
(Northern Ireland) 1978***Made* 18th October 1978*Coming into operation* 4th December 1978

The Department of the Environment for Northern Ireland in exercise of the powers conferred by section 60 of the Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a) and now vested in it(b) hereby makes and confirms the following Bye-Laws:—

Citation and commencement

1. These Bye-Laws may be cited as the Motor Hackney Carriage (Newry) (Amendment) Bye-Laws (Northern Ireland) 1978 and shall come into operation on 4th December 1978.

Bye-Laws amended

2. The Bye-Laws made in respect of Motor Hackney Carriages standing or plying for hire by the Urban District Council of Newry on 8th April 1968 and confirmed by the Ministry of Home Affairs on 25th April 1968 shall be amended as follows:—

- (a) In bye-law 3 for the words “stands for Motor Hackney Carriages” there shall be substituted “stands for the number of Motor Hackney Carriages specified in column 3 of the said Schedule”; and
(b) For the Schedule there shall be substituted the following—

Monaghan Street	South side from a point 166 metres West of its junction with Mer- chants Quay to a point 171 metres West of that junction. Motor Hackney Carriage to face West.	1”
