Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions (Amendment No. 3) Regulations 1978

Made . 13th November 1978

1st December 1978 Coming into operation .

To be laid before Parliament

The Secretary of State, in pursuance of section 25 of the Police Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a) and after consulting, in accordance with section 34(2) of the said Act, the Police Authority for Northern Ireland and the Police Association for Northern Ireland, and, in accordance with section 4(5) of the Police Act 1969(b), the Police Council for the United Kingdom, hereby with the concurrence of the Minister for the Civil Service makes the following regulations:

PART T

CITATION, COMMENCEMENT AND INTERPRETATION

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions (Amendment No. 3) Regulations 1978 and shall come into operation on 1st December 1978.

Interpretation

- 2. In these regulations—
- "the Order of 1949" means the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions Order 1949(c):
- "the principal regulations" means the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions Regulations 1973(d).

PART II

AMENDMENTS TO THE ORDER OF 1949

Widow's ordinary pension

- 3. Appendix II to the Schedule to the Order of 1949 shall be amended as follows:
 - (a) In both Part I (widow's flat-rate ordinary pension) and paragraph 3 of Part VIII (widow's ordinary pension—alternative rate)—
 - (i) for "£10.60" there shall be substituted "£11.39";
 - (ii) for "£9.19" there shall be substituted "£9.87";
 - (iii) for "£7.85" there shall be substituted "£8.43";

(b) In paragraph 4 of the said Part VIII (increase in alternative rate) for "52p" there shall be substituted "56p".

Child's ordinary allowance

- 4. Pant I of Appendix III to the Schedule to the Order of 1949 shall be amended as follows:
 - (a) In paragraph 1 (child's ordinary allowance—one parent living)—
 - (i) for "£3.24" there shall be substituted "£3.48";
 - (ii) for "£2.81" there shall be substituted "£3.02";
 - (iii) for "£2.58" there shall be substituted "£2.77";
 - (b) in paragraph 2 (child's ordinary allowance—both parents dead)—
 - (i) for "£5.33" there shall be substituted "£5.73";
 - (ii) for "£4.58" there shall be substituted "£4.92";
 - (iii) for "£3.94" there shall be substituted "£4.24".

PART III

AMENDMENTS TO THE PRINCIPAL REGULATIONS

Discretionary pension for widow of serviceman

5. In regulation 82(5) of the principal regulations for "£7.85" there shall be substituted "£8.43".

Widow's pension

- 6. Schedule 3 to the principal regulations shall be amended as follows:
 - (a) In Part I, paragraph 3 (widow's alternative flat rate ordinary pension)—
 - (i) for "£10.60" there shall be substituted "£11.39";
 - (ii) for "£9.19" there shall be substituted "£9.87";
 - (iii) for "£7.85" there shall be substituted "£8.43";
 - (iv) for "52p" there shall be substituted "56p".
 - (b) In Part IV, paragraph 4 (widow's alternative flat rate accrued pension)—
 - (i) for "£10.60" there shall be substituted "£11.39";
 - (ii) for "£9.19" there shall be substituted "£9.87";
 - (iii) for "£7.85" there shall be substituted "£8.43".

Child's ordinary allowance

- 7. Schedule 4 to the principal regulations shall be amended as follows:
- (a) In Part I, paragraph 1(4) (child's alternative flat rate ordinary allow-ance—one parent living)—
 - (i) for "£3.24" there shall be substituted "£3.48";
 - (ii) for "£2.81" there shall be substituted "£3.02";
 - (iii) for "£2.58" there shall be substituted "£2.77";
- (b) In Part I, paragraph 2(4) (child's alternative flat rate ordinary allow-ance—both parents dead)—
 - (i) for "£4.84" there shall be substituted "£5.20";
 - (ii) for "£4.21" there shall be substituted "£4.53";
 - (iii) for "£3.86" there shall be substituted "£4.15"

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These regulations amend the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions Order 1949 and the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions Regulations 1973.

The amendments increase certain widows' pensions and children's allowances payable under those instruments.

The regulations take effect as from 1st December 1978 (the date from which increases authorised by the Pensions Increase (Annual Review) Order 1978 are payable).
