**The Industrial Relations (1976 No. 2 Order) (Commencement No. 4)  
Order (Northern Ireland) 1978***Made* . . . . . 1st December 1978*Coming into operation* . . . . . 1st January 1979

The Department of Manpower Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 1 of the Industrial Relations (No. 2) (Northern Ireland) Order 1976(a) and paragraph 2(1) and (2) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Industrial Relations (1976 No. 2 Order) (Commencement No. 4) Order (Northern Ireland) 1978 and shall come into effect on 1st January 1979.

*Appointed day*

2. Articles 37 and 38 of the Industrial Relations (No. 2) (Northern Ireland) Order 1976, which relate to time off for trade union duties and activities, shall come into operation on 1st January 1979.
