ROAD AND RAILWAY TRANSPORT

The Road Freight Transport Licensing (Amendment) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1978

Made 14th February 1978

Coming into operation 1st April 1978

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 45(d) and (e) of the Transport Act (Northern Ireland) 1967(a), and now vested in it(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Freight Transport Licensing (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1978 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1978.

Amendment of Regulations

2. The Road Freight Transport Licensing Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1968(c) shall be amended as follows:

(a) For Regulation 8(1)(b) there shall be substituted:

“(b) Immediately upon the expiration of twenty-eight days after the service of a notice under sub-paragraph (a) the vehicle licence to which the notice relates shall be suspended or revoked in accordance with the decision set out in the notice unless the holder of the licence has made an application to have the decision reviewed in accordance with paragraph (2)(a).”

(b) For Regulation 8(2) there shall be substituted:

“(2)(a) The holder of a vehicle licence aggrieved by the decision to suspend or revoke the licence may within fourteen days from the service of the notice under paragraph (1) apply in writing to the Department requiring the decision to be reviewed by the Department and stating the grounds on which he bases his application.

(b) On receiving an application under sub-paragraph (a) the Department shall review the decision and shall serve a further notice in writing upon the applicant informing him whether the decision has been confirmed or reversed or in what way the decision has been varied as a result of such review.

(c) Where the decision has not been varied or where it has been varied so as to suspend or revoke a vehicle licence the licence shall be suspended or revoked immediately upon the expiration of twenty-eight days after the service of the notice under sub-paragraph (1)(a) or upon the expiration of seven days after the service of the further notice under sub-paragraph (b) whichever last occurs."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations amend Regulation 8 of the Principal Regulations by permitting the holder of a road freight vehicle licence, aggrieved by a decision of the Department of the Environment to suspend or revoke the licence, to apply to the Department to have the decision reviewed. On receipt of such an application the Department must review the decision and inform the applicant of the result.
