## ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

**Compulsory Right or Left-Hand Turn (Belfast) Order  
(Northern Ireland) 1979**

*Made* . . . . . 23rd April 1979

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 4th June 1979

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 19 of the Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a) hereby makes the following Order:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Compulsory Right or Left-Hand Turn (Belfast) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979 and shall come into operation on 4th June 1979.

*Compulsory right-hand turn*

2. Every person causing or permitting a vehicle to proceed in the roads specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit that vehicle, on reaching the junctions with the roads specified opposite thereto in column 2 to make a right-hand turn into those roads while proceeding in the direction specified in column 3.

*Compulsory left-hand turn*

3. Every person causing or permitting a vehicle to proceed in the roads specified in column 1 of Schedule 2 shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit that vehicle, on reaching the junctions with the roads specified opposite thereto in column 2 to make a left-hand turn into those roads while proceeding in the direction specified in column 3.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)*

This Order gives legal backing to traffic signs which have been erected on certain streets in Belfast requiring traffic to make a right or left-hand turn as indicated by the traffic sign.

Any person who acts in contravention of this Order shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine of £100.

**Medicines (Chloroform Prohibition) Order 1979**
