**ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES****Roads (Control of Builders' Skips) (Amendment) Regulations  
(Northern Ireland) 1979***Made* . . . . . 14th May 1979*Coming into operation* . . . . . 4th June 1979

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on it by article 3(2) of the Roads and Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1978(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Roads (Control of Builders' Skips) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1979 and shall come into operation on 4th June 1979.

*Revocation*

2. Regulations 3 and 4 of the Roads (Control of Builders' Skips) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1979(b) are hereby revoked.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)*

The purpose of this amendment is to remove from the regulations a restriction relating to the depositing of a skip in such a position as to cause or to be likely to cause any obstruction or danger. Such depositing of skips is already an offence under Part II of the Order. It also removes the authority purportedly conferred on the Department to authorise the depositing of skips in certain circumstances.
