**Rates (Regional Rate and Reduction of Regional Rate on Dwellings)  
Order (Northern Ireland) 1979**

*Made* . . . . . 1st February 1979

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 1st April 1979

*To be laid before Parliament under Paragraph 3(3) of  
Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974*

The Department of Finance in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 7 and 27 of the Rates (Northern Ireland) Order 1977(a) and of any other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Rates (Regional Rate and Reduction of Regional Rate on Dwellings) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1979.

*Regional rate*

2. The regional rate for the year ending on 31st March 1980 shall be 60·8 pence in the pound.

*Reduction of regional rate on dwellings*

3. The amount by which the regional rate fixed for the year ending on 31st March 1980 under Article 2 is to be reduced in respect of dwellings for the purposes of paragraph (2) and paragraph (3) of Article 27 of the Rates (Northern Ireland) Order 1977 shall be 12 pence.
