WELFARE OF ANIMALS

Welfare of Animals (Fees) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979

Made 17th August 1979

Coming into operation 15th November 1979

To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 3(3) of
Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974

The Department(a) of Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 8(3) of the Welfare of Animals Act (Northern Ireland) 1972(b) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, with the approval of the Department of Finance hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Welfare of Animals (Fees) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979 and shall come into operation on 15th November 1979.

Revocation

2. The Welfare of Animals (Fees) Order (Northern Ireland) 1972(c) is hereby revoked.

Licence fees

3. The fee payable for a licence granted under section 8(1) of the Act shall be—

- (a) in respect of a petshop the sum of £20;
- (b) in respect of an animal boarding establishment the sum of £25; and
- (c) in respect of a riding establishment or a zoological establishment the sum of £75.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order revokes the Welfare of Animals (Fees) Order (Northern Ireland) 1972 and prescribes the new increased fees payable for licences to keep petshops, animal boarding establishments, and riding and zoological establishments.
