DEVELOPMENT OF TOURIST TRAFFIC

Catering Establishments (Amendment) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1979

Made 5th September 1979

Coming into operation 1st November 1979

The Department(a) of Commerce in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 11 and 34(1) of the Development of Tourist Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1948(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, on the recommendation of the Northern Ireland Tourist Board, hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Catering Establishments (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1979 and shall come into operation on 1st November 1979.

Amendment of existing regulations

2.—(1) In regulations 4 and 5 of the Catering Establishments Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1953(c) (qualifications for registration of boarding houses and restaurants) the words "in the opinion of the Board" shall be deleted.

(2) In regulation 4 of the Registration of Catering Establishments (Hotels) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1967(d) (qualifications for registration of hotels) the words "in the opinion of the Board" shall be deleted.

(3) In regulation 2 of the Registration of Catering Establishments (Guest Houses) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1968(e) (qualifications for registration of guest houses) the words "in the opinion of the Board" shall be deleted.

(4) In regulation 2 of the Catering Establishments (Self Catering) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1978(f) (qualifications for registration of self catering establishments) the words "in its opinion" shall be deleted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
