HOUSING

Housing (Determination of Unfitness) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979

Made 26th October 1979

Coming into operation 1st January 1980

*To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 3(3) of
Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974*

The Department of the Environment for Northern Ireland in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6(6) of the Housing (Ireland) Act 1919(a) and section 29(7) of the Planning and Housing Act (Northern Ireland) 1931(b) and now vested in it(c) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Housing (Determination of Unfitness) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1980.

Increase of multiplier

2. The multiplier in the definition of "reasonable expense" in section 6(6) of the Housing (Ireland) Act 1919 and in section 29(7) of the Planning and Housing Act (Northern Ireland) 1931 shall be twenty-one times.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order prescribes a multiplier of twenty-one times in place of fifteen times the net annual value for the purposes of determining the reasonable expenses of making a house fit for human habitation in accordance with section 6(6) of the Housing (Ireland) Act 1919 and sections 29 and 30 of the Planning and Housing Act (Northern Ireland) 1931.
