Pig Production Development (Contribution) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979

Made 11th December 1979

Coming into operation 14th January 1980

The Department(a) of Agriculture, on the recommendation of the Northern Ireland Pig Production Development Committee and in exercise of the power conferred on it by section 4(1)(b) of the Pig Production Development Act (Northern Ireland) 1964(c) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Pig Production Development (Contribution) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979 and shall come into operation on 14th January 1980.

Determination of contribution

2. The amount of the contribution to be paid by every person who sells pigs to the Pigs Marketing Board shall be 0.225 per cent of the payment made by that Board to that person in respect of such pigs.

Revocation

3. The Pig Production Development (Contribution) Order (Northern Ireland) 1978(d) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order replaces the Pig Production Development (Contribution) Order (Northern Ireland) 1978. It reduces the amount payable by pig producers to the Pig Production Development Fund from 0.275 to 0.225 per cent of the producer's returns received from the Pigs Marketing Board.
