# Road Traffic (Payment of Fixed Penalty) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979

Made . . . . . . . . . . 27th December 1979 Coming into operation . . . 4th February 1980

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred by section 175(1) of the Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a) (in this Order referred to as "the Act") and now vested in it(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby orders and directs as follows:

# Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Payment of Fixed Penalty) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979 and shall come into operation on 4th February 1980.

#### Revocation

2. The Road Traffic (Payment of Fixed Penalty) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979(c) is hereby revoked.

## Direction

3. In the petty sessions districts of Antrim, Ards, Belfast, Carrickfergus, Castlereagh, Lisburn, Newtownabbey and North Down, for the purposes of section 175 of the Act in the case of an offence to which sections 172 to 177 of the Act apply, payment of a fixed penalty shall be made to the Payments Officer at the Fixed Penalty Notice Office, Belfast.

# EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order takes account of the petty sessions districts into which Northern Ireland is now divided. It revokes the Order mentioned in Regulation 2 and adds the petty sessions district of Antrim to those where payment of a fixed penalty is made at the Fixed Penalty Notice Office in Belfast.
