The Judgment Enforcement (Fees) (Amendment) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1979

Made 27th February 1979

Coming into operation 27th March 1979

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 116 of the Judicature (Northern Ireland) Act 1978(a), and after consultation with the Lord Chief Justice of Northern Ireland, and with the concurrence of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Judgment Enforcement (Fees) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979 and shall come into force on 27th March 1979.

2. In Part I of Schedule 2 to the Judgment Enforcement (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1970(b), as amended(c) after fee number 9 there shall be added the following fee:—

“10. On the lodging of a notice of intention to enforce under rule 4 of the Judgment Enforcement Rules;
in respect of each person to be served £2.00”
