ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Restriction of Traffic (Lough Shore Lurgan) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979

Made....13th March 1979Coming into operation....30th April 1979

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment (in this Order referred to as "the Department") is satisfied that the roads described in the schedule are unsuitable for use by certain classes of vehicles:

Now THEREFORE the Department in exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a) and now vested in it(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Restriction of Traffic (Lough Shore Lurgan) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979 and shall come into operation on 30th April 1979.

2.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2) the roads described in the schedule shall not be used by vehicles exceeding three tons in laden weight.

(2) Paragraph (1) shall not apply to the use of the roads described in the schedule by vehicles exceeding three tons in laden weight where such vehicles are being used either by the owners or occupiers of premises or lands abutting on or convenient to the said roads or in connection with the delivery to or collection from such premises or lands of goods of any kind or in connection with public utility or emergency services.

SCHEDULE

Roads referred to

(1) Hall Rampart, Bay Rampart and Skeltons Rampart in the townland of Derrytrasna, Borough of Craigavon and County of Armagh between their junctions with Ardmore Road (Route C160) and Derrytrasna Road (Route B2).

(2) Pier Rampart and Byrnes Rampart in the townland of Derrytagh North, Borough of Craigavon and County of Armagh between their junctions with Ardmore Road (Route C160) and Derrytrasna Road (Route B2).

(3) Lenny's Road in the townland of Derryadd, Borough of Craigavon and County of Armagh between its junctions with Church Road and Derrytrasna Road (Route B2).

(4) Church Road in the townlands of Derryadd, Ardmore and Derrytagh North, Borough of Craigavon and County of Armagh from its junction with Pier Rampart to its junction with Ardmore Road.
