# Matrimonial Causes (1978 Order) (Commencement No. 3) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Article 1(2) of the Matrimonial Causes (Northern Ireland) Order 1978(a) I hereby make the following Order:—

#### Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Matrimonial Causes (1978 Order) (Commencement No. 3) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979 and shall come into operation on 18th April 1979.

## Appointed day

2. The day appointed for the coming into operation of such provisions of the Matrimonial Causes (Northern Ireland) Order 1978 as are not in force at the date of the making of this Order shall be 18th April 1979.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Order, but it is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The Order brings into operation on 18th April 1979 those provisions of the Matrimonial Causes (Northern Ireland) Order 1978 in respect of which a previous Commencement Order has not been made.

Commencement (No. 1) Order brought Article 56 into operation on 16th October 1978. The Article amended the Summary Jurisdiction (Separation and Maintenance) Act (Northern Ireland) 1945.

Commencement (No. 2) Order brought into operation on 15th January 1979 those Articles which enabled the Northern Ireland Matrimonial Rules Committee to be constituted and rules of court to be made.
