## LANDLORD AND TENANT

## The Registered Rents (Increase) Order (Northern Ireland) 1980

*Made* . . . . . 10th April 1980  
*Coming into operation* . . . . . 5th May 1980

The Department of the Environment, having acted in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by Article 33(1) of the Rent (Northern Ireland) Order 1978(a) (hereinafter called "the Order") and having determined that the rents hereinafter mentioned should be increased, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 33(2) of the Order and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. This order may be cited as the Registered Rents (Increase) Order (Northern Ireland) 1980 and shall come into operation on 5th May 1980.

*Increase of registered rents*

2. The rents registered under Part V of the Order for dwelling-houses which are let under regulated tenancies shall be increased by twenty-seven per cent.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)*

This order increases the rents of regulated tenancies registered with the Department of the Environment by twenty-seven per cent from 5th May 1980. Under Article 22(4) of the Rent (Northern Ireland) Order 1978 a notice of increase of rent which gives effect to such increases shall not take effect earlier than four weeks after the commencement of this order, i.e., until 2nd June 1980.

Before a landlord may recover the increased rent he must give a tenant at least four weeks' notice of the increase.
