Police Cadets (Pensions) (Amendment) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1980

Made 6th May 1980

Coming into operation 1st July 1980

To be laid before Parliament

The Secretary of State, in pursuance of section 10 of the Police Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a) read with Articles 14 and 15 of the Superannuation (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(b) and after consulting the Police Council for the United Kingdom and in accordance with section 34(2) of the said Act, the Police Authority for Northern Ireland and the Police Association for Northern Ireland, hereby with the concurrence of the Minister for the Civil Service makes the following regulations:—

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Police Cadets (Pensions) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1980.

Commencement and effect

2. These regulations shall come into operation on 1st July 1980 and shall have effect—

- (a) for the purposes of paragraph (a) of regulation 3, as from 24th January 1975;
- (b) for the purposes of paragraph (b) of that regulation, as from 6th April 1978.

3. The Police Cadets (Pensions) (No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973(c), shall have effect—

- (a) from 24th January 1975 subject to the amendments specified in Part I of the Schedule to these regulations;
- (b) from 6th April 1978 subject to the amendments specified in Part II of that Schedule.

PART I

Amendment taking effect from 24th January 1975

1. In paragraph (2) of regulation 2, after the words "regulations 4, 5, 9" there shall be inserted "10A".

PART II

Amendments taking effect from 6th April 1978

1. In regulation 10 there shall be inserted after paragraph (2) the following paragraphs:—

"(3) Regulation 28 of the principal regulations, as so applied, shall have effect as if the words "before he has attained insured pensionable age" were omitted therefrom.

(4) Regulation 31 of the principal regulations, as so applied shall have effect as if paragraph (3) were omitted therefrom."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

The Police Cadets (Pensions) (No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973 give to police cadets and their dependants certain pension benefits, for which members of the Royal Ulster Constabulary and their dependants are eligible, by applying certain provisions of the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions Regulations 1973.

These regulations amend the Police Cadets (Pensions) (No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973 to attract amendments to the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions Regulations 1973 effected by the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 1976 and the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 1978 from the appropriate dates subject to the exclusion of particular provisions. Retrospection is authorised by Articles 14 and 15 of the Superannuation (Northern Ireland) Order 1972.
