Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Pensions) (Amendment) Regulations 1980

The Secretary of State, in pursuance of section 26 of the Police Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a) read with Articles 14 and 15 of the Superannuation (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(b) and after consulting in accordance with section 34(2) of the said Act, the Police Authority for Northern Ireland and the Police Association for Northern Ireland, hereby with the concurrence of the Minister for the Civil Service makes the following regulations:—

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Pensions) (Amendment) Regulations 1980.

Commencement and effect

- 2. These regulations shall come into operation on 1st July 1980 and shall have effect as from 6th April 1978.
- 3. The Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Pensions) Regulations 1973(c) shall have effect from 6th April 1978 subject to the amendment specified in the Schedule to these regulations.

SCHEDULE

Regulation 3

Amendment taking effect from 6th April 1978

In regulation 5-

- (a) for the words "Regulations 25, 28(1), 30, 31 and 32" in paragraph (2) there shall be substituted the words "regulations 25, 28, 30, 31 and 32"; and
- (b) there shall be inserted after paragraph (2) the following paragraphs:—
- "(3) Regulation 28 of the principal regulations, as so applied, shall have effect as if the words "before he has attained insured pensionable age" were omitted therefrom.
- (4) Regulation 31 of the principal regulations, as so applied, shall have effect as if paragraph (3) were omitted therefrom.".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

The Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Pensions) Regulations 1973 give to members of the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve and their dependants certain pension benefits, for which members of the Royal Ulster Constabulary and their dependants are eligible, by applying certain provisions of the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions Regulations 1973.

These regulations amend the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Pensions) Regulations 1973 to attract amendments to the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions Regulations 1973 effected by the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 1978 subject to the exclusion of particular provisions. Retrospection is authorised by Articles 14 and 15 of the Superannuation (Northern Ireland) Order 1972.
