**Teachers' Salaries (Amendment No. 2) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1980**

Made 2nd July 1980

Coming into operation 30th July 1980

The Department(a) of Education, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 57(1) and 125(1) of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(b) and by section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962(c) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, after consultation with the Department(a) of Finance, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Teachers' Salaries (Amendment No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1980 and shall come into operation on 30th July 1980 and shall have effect on and from 1st January 1980.

Amendment of regulations

2. The Teachers' Salaries Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1978(d) are hereby amended in accordance with the following provisions of these regulations and references in these regulations to a numbered regulation or a numbered schedule, in the absence of a provision to the contrary, are references to the regulation or schedule so numbered in the Teachers' Salaries Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1978.

Salary scales

3. For Schedule 1 there shall be substituted the Schedule set out in Annex A to these regulations.

Principals: additional provisions relating to scales and allowances

4. In regulation 11(2) for "£285" there shall be substituted "£288".

Peripatetic and supply teachers: salaries

5. In regulation 23(2) for "£474" there shall be substituted "£480".

Allowance for teachers of handicapped pupils

6. In regulation 25(1) and (2) for "£474" there shall be substituted "£480".

Unqualified teachers: minimum salary

7. In regulation 33 for "£2,634" there shall be substituted "£2,673".

Part-time teachers: payment

8. In regulation 36(1) for the rates per hour of "£4.44", "£3.68" and "£3.04" there shall be substituted "£4.50", "£3.73" and "£3.08" respectively.

Transfer to salary scales at 1st January 1980

9. In paragraph 2(a) and (b) of Part I of Schedule 2 for “£6,276” and “£6,747” there shall be substituted “£6,363” and “£6,843” respectively.

*Provisions affecting salary placing***10.** In Part II of Schedule 2—

- (1) In paragraph 2(b) for the words “the Principal Regulations” there shall be substituted “these Regulations”;
- (2) In paragraphs 9(2) and (3) for “£474” there shall be substituted “£480”.

*Incremental credit on scale 1***11.** In paragraph 4 of Schedule 5—

- (1) for “£81” there shall be substituted “£84”;
- (2) for “£144” there shall be substituted “£147”;
- (3) for “£162” there shall be substituted “£165”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These regulations introduce from 1st January 1980 revised scales of salary (Annex A) for teachers in primary schools, secondary schools (other than technical intermediate schools) and special schools and for peripatetic and supply teachers.

The allowance for an unqualified teacher serving as a principal has been increased (regulation 4).

The allowance for teachers of handicapped pupils has been increased (regulation 6).

The rate of salary for an unqualified teacher has been increased (regulation 7).

Regulation 8 provides new rates of payment for part-time teachers.

Regulations 9 to 11 update the arrangements affecting salary placings on the new salary scales.

The regulations have retrospective effect by virtue of section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962.
