**Local Bodies (Emergency Powers) Act (Northern Ireland) 1971
(Repeal) Order (Northern Ireland) 1980**

Made 4th August 1980
Coming into operation 4th August 1980

WHEREAS it appears to me that the provisions of the Local Bodies (Emergency Powers) Act (Northern Ireland) 1971(a) are no longer likely to be required, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 4(2) of that Act as adapted by section 40 of and paragraph 4(2) of Schedule 5 to the Northern Ireland Constitution Act 1973(b), I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Local Bodies (Emergency Powers) Act (Northern Ireland) 1971 (Repeal) Order (Northern Ireland) 1980 and shall come into operation on 4th August 1980.

2. The Local Bodies (Emergency Powers) Act (Northern Ireland) 1971 is hereby repealed.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order provides for the repeal of the Local Bodies (Emergency Powers) Act (Northern Ireland) 1971. That Act allows the Secretary of State in Part I to make Orders for the performance of the functions of certain bodies, if the bodies refuse, neglect or fail to perform them and in Part II to dissolve certain bodies and to make ancillary provision in connection with such dissolution, if the bodies fail to perform any of the functions imposed on or vested in those bodies.
