The Department(a) of Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 1(1)(b), 2(2) and (4) of the Seeds Act (Northern Ireland) 1965(c) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, after consultation with representatives of such interests as appear to it to be concerned and with the approval of the Department(a) of Finance with regard to the licensing fee for licensed testing establishments hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Seeds (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1980 and shall come into operation on 13th October 1980.

Revocation

2. The Seeds (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1979(d) are hereby revoked.

Fees

3.—(1) There shall be paid in advance in respect of matters arising under the regulations referred to in Schedules 1 to 6 the fees set out in the second column of each of those Schedules opposite the respective references to such matters in the first column of each of such Schedules.

(2) The Department shall repay to an applicant one-half of any initial fee paid by an applicant in accordance with Schedules 1 to 5 if the application in respect of which the initial fee was paid is withdrawn by the applicant before:

- (a) the date of inspection of the crop in respect of which the application was made; or
- (b) the date set out by the Department for notification of withdrawal of such applications;

whichever date is the earlier.

Persons to whom fees are payable

4.--(1) Where---

- (a) the inspection of a crop is undertaken by a licensed crop inspector; or
- (b) the sampling of a seed lot is undertaken by a licensed seed sampler; or
- (c) a testing of a sample of seeds is undertaken by a licensed testing establishment;

the fees for such inspection, sampling or testing shall be payable to the licensed crop inspector, the licensed seed sampler or the licensed testing establishment as the case may be.

(2) In sub-paragraphs (a) and (b) of paragraph (1) "licensed" means licensed under regulation 8 of the Seeds (Registration and Licensing) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1974(e).

Exemption

5. The Department may exempt any person or class of persons or persons generally from compliance in whole or in part with the provisions of these regulations in relation to payment of fees and any exemptions so made may be subject to conditions.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These regulations which are made under the Seeds Act (Northern Ireland) 1965 supersede the Seeds (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1979.

The regulations increase with a few exceptions all fees in respect of matters arising under the Cereal Seeds Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976, the Fodder Plant Seeds Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976, the Beet Seeds Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976, the Oil and Fibre Plant Seeds Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976, the Vegetable Seeds Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976 and the Seeds (Registration and Licensing) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1974.

The fees which remain unchanged are those shown in Schedules 1. C.(iv) and E.(iv)(b), 2. D.(i) and E.(xi)(b), 3. D. and 5. D.(i).
