Official Assignee (Official Seal) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1980

Made 16th September 1980

Coming into operation 1st November 1980

The Department of Commerce, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 34(2) of the Bankruptcy Amendment (Northern Ireland) Order 1980(a) ("the Order") and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Official Assignee (Official Seal) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1980 and shall come into operation on 1st November 1980.

Official Seal

2.—(1) The Official Assignee shall have an official seal.

(2) The Officer appointed to be Official Assignee under Article 3(1) of the Order shall provide for the safe custody of the official seal which shall be used only by his authority or by the authority of an Assistant Official Assignee.

(3) Every document to which the official seal is affixed shall be signed by the Official Assignee or by an Assistant Official Assignee.
