# **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This Order brings into operation Article 12 of the Administration of Justice (Northern Ireland) Order 1975, which enables a clerk of petty sessions to exercise the functions of a justice of the peace in relation to the making of complaints (other than complaints on oath) and the issue of summonses.
