ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Traffic (Weight Restriction) (No. 3) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1980

Made 6th November 1980

Coming into operation 17th November 1980

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a) and now vested in it(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, and being satisfied that the road described in article 2 is unsuitable for use by certain classes of vehicles, hereby makes the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Traffic (Weight Restriction) (No. 3) Order (Northern Ireland) 1980 and shall come into operation on 17th November 1980.

Prohibition

2. Subject to article 3 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle the weight of which whether laden or unladen exceeds 3 tons to proceed on that length of Mussenden Road (Route A2) Downhill, County Londonderry, which extends from its junction with Burrenmore Road, (Route DR 316) for a distance of 525 metres in a north-westerly direction.

Exemptions

3. The prohibition in article 2 shall not apply to:—

- (a) an Education and Library Board lightweight bus, operated by Ulsterbus Limited and carrying not more than its seating capacity of 28 passengers and the driver;
- (b) vehicles used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes; and
- (c) vehicles engaged in works being executed on or near the length of road.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The effect of this order is to prohibit vehicles exceeding 3 tons laden or unladen weight from using that length of Mussenden Road (Route A2), Downhill, Co. Londonderry, which extends from its junction with Burrenmore Road (Route DR 316) for a distance of 525 metres in a north-westerly direction.

The order makes provision for the use of the length of road by an Education and Library Board lightweight bus operated by Ulsterbus Limited, emergency service vehicles and vehicles engaged in works being executed.

Any person who acts in contravention of the order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £100.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the order have been erected on the road.
