The Department of Commerce, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 2(1)(a) of the Payments for Debt (Emergency Provisions) Act (Northern Ireland) 1971(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, with the approval of the Department(c) of Finance hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Payments for Debt (Costs of Collection) (Revocation) Order (Northern Ireland) 1980 and shall come into operation on 24th November 1980.

Revocation

2. The Payments for Debt (Costs of Collection) Order (Northern Ireland) 1978(d) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order revokes the Payments for Debt (Costs of Collection) Order (Northern Ireland) 1978 which, among other things, requires payment by a person or his spouse of the costs of collecting out of monies due to either of them from certain public funds any sums recoverable under the Payments for Debt (Emergency Provisions) Act (Northern Ireland) 1971 in respect of outstanding debts due for electricity or gas.
