ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Heavy Goods Vehicles (Drivers' Licences) (Amendment)
Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1980

Made 18th November 1980

Coming into operation 18th November 1980

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 66(3)(c), 71, 183 and 189 of the Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a) and now vested in it(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Heavy Goods Vehicles (Drivers' Licences) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1980 and shall come into operation on 18th November 1980.

Regulation amended

2. In regulation 23(1) of the Heavy Goods Vehicles (Drivers' Licences) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1970(c) after sub-paragraph (v) there shall be inserted the following sub-paragraph—

“(w) any vehicle when being driven by a member of the armed forces of the Crown in the course of urgent work of national importance in accordance with an order of the Defence Council in pursuance of the Defence (Armed Forces) Regulations 1939(d), which were continued permanently in force, in the form set out in Part C of Schedule 2 to the Emergency Laws (Repeal) Act 1959(e), by section 2 of the Emergency Powers Act 1964(f).”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations further amend the Heavy Goods Vehicles (Drivers' Licences) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1970. They introduce an exemption from heavy goods vehicle driver licensing in the case of vehicles being driven by members of the Armed Forces in the course of urgent work of national importance under instructions given by the Defence Council under the Defence (Armed Forces) Regulations 1939.
