## SOCIAL SECURITY

**The Child Benefit (General) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations  
(Northern Ireland) 1980**

*Made* . . . . . 21st November 1980

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 1st January 1981

The Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 6(1) of, and paragraph 1(f) of Schedule 1 to, the Child Benefit (Northern Ireland) Order 1975(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

*Citation, commencement and interpretation*

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Child Benefit (General) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1980 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1981.

(2) In these regulations “the principal regulations” means the Child Benefit (General) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1979(b).

*Amendment of regulation 18 of the principal regulations*

2. In regulation 18(5) of the principal regulations (children in detention, care, etc.) after sub-paragraph (d) there shall be added the following sub-paragraph—

“(e) committed to the care of the Department under a care order made under Article 12 of the Domestic Proceedings (Northern Ireland) Order 1980(c).”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)*

These regulations further amend the Child Benefit (General) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1979 ("the principal regulations").

They extend the scope of regulation 18(5) of the principal regulations (child in care of the Department or the subject of a parental rights order in such circumstances as may be prescribed) so as to include a child committed to the care of the Department of Health and Social Services under a care order made under Article 12 of the Domestic Proceedings (Northern Ireland) Order 1980.
