ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES**Motor Cycles (Protective Headgear) (Amendment)
Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1980**

Made 15th December 1980

Coming into operation 5th January 1981

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 114 and 189 of the Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a) and now vested in it(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Cycles (Protective Headgear) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1980 and shall come into operation on 5th January 1981.

Regulation amended

2. In regulation 4(2)(a) of the Motor Cycles (Protective Headgear) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1980(c) for the word "moving" there shall be substituted the word "mowing".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations amend the Motor Cycles (Protective Headgear) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1980 by correcting a printing error in regulation 4(2)(a) where the word "moving" should have read "mowing".
