ULSTER SAVINGS CERTIFICATES

Ulster Savings Certificates (Nineteenth Issue) Regulations 1980

Made 4th January 1980

Coming into operation 4th February 1980

The Department(a) of Finance in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 15(1) of the Exchequer and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1950(b) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following regulations:—

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Ulster Savings Certificates (Nineteenth Issue) Regulations 1980 and shall be construed as one with the Ulster Savings Certificates Regulations 1962 to 1979(c) and those regulations and these regulations may be cited together as the Ulster Savings Certificates Regulations 1962 to 1980.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on 4th February 1980.

2.—(1) For paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 2 to the Ulster Savings Certificates Regulations 1962(d) there shall be substituted the following paragraphs:—

“1. The purchase price of a unit certificate shall be ten pounds.

2. The amount repayable in respect of a unit certificate shall be as follows:—

Within one year from date of purchase ten pounds.

On and after the termination of one year from the date of purchase ten pounds and fifty pence with a further addition of thirty pence in respect of each successive completed period of four months during the second year of currency and thirty-five pence in respect of each successive completed period of four months during the third year of currency and fifty-five pence in respect of each successive completed period of four months during the fourth year of currency and seventy-five pence in respect of each successive completed period of four months during the fifth year of currency”.

(2) Certificates to which this regulation applies shall be inscribed “19th Issue”.

(3) This regulation applies only to certificates of the Nineteenth Issue issued on or after 4th February 1980.

3. Schedule 3 to the Ulster Savings Certificates Regulations 1962(e) (which Schedule prescribes the maximum number of certificates which may be held), shall be further amended by substituting for paragraph (l) of the said Schedule the following paragraphs:—

“(l) one hundred and fifty, in the case of certificates issued between 29th January 1979 and 2nd February 1980 (known as the Eighteenth Issue); and

(m) One hundred and fifty, in the case of certificates issued on or after 4th February 1980 (known as the Nineteenth Issue)”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations prescribe the terms governing the issue of Ulster Savings Certificates of the Nineteenth Issue which is to commence on 4th February 1980 and also set a maximum holding which a person may have in addition to the permitted maxima of Ulster Savings Certificates of other Issues.
