## Ulster Savings Certificates (Ninth Issue) Regulations 1981

The Department(a) of Finance in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Sections 15(1) and 16(1) of the Exchequer and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1950(b) as amended by Section 2 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962(c) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following regulations:

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Ulster Savings Certificates (Ninth Issue) Regulations 1981 and shall come into operation on 1st August 1981.
- 2. The currency of any Ulster Savings Certificate issued on or after 1st August 1956 and before 13th March 1963 at the purchase price of fifteen shillings (75p) for each unit Certificate (being Certificates of the Ninth Issue) shall be prolonged to a date twenty seven years after the date of purchase of that Certificate.
- 3. Interest shall be added to Certificates of the Ninth Issue after the twenty sixth anniversary of the date of purchase at the rate of Seven and one half pence (7½p) in respect of each unit Certificate for each completed period of four months.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations extend the currency of Ulster Savings Certificates of the Ninth Issue for a further year, i.e., from twenty six years to twenty seven years from date of purchase and prescribe the interest per unit Certificate during the further year of extension at the rate of twenty two and one half pence. Ninth Issue Certificates were introduced by S.R. & O. (N.I.) 1956 No. 109 since when there have been 6 extensions of currency — S.R. & O. (N.I.) 1963 No. 63; 1966 No. 100; 1970 No. 236; S.R. 1975 No. 184; 1976 No. 271 and S.R. 1980 No. 270.
