HEALTH AND PERSONAL SOCIAL SERVICES**Linguistic Knowledge for General Medical Services and
General Dental Services (Northern Ireland) Regulations 1981***Made* 9th July 1981*Coming into operation* 1st August 1981

The Department(a) of Health and Social Services in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 56 and 61 of the Health and Personal Social Services (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(b) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and after consultation with such organisations as appeared to the Department to be representative of the medical and dental professions hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Linguistic Knowledge for General Medical Services and General Dental Services (Northern Ireland) Regulations 1981 and shall come into operation on 1st August 1981.

Amendment to provisions for General Medical Services

2. In regulation 12(1) of the Health and Personal Social Services (General Medical and Pharmaceutical Services) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973(c) after the words "A doctor" there shall be inserted the words "not disentitled by virtue of the provisions of Article 56(2A) of the Order".

Amendment to provisions for General Dental Services

3. Regulation 4(1) of the Health and Personal Social Services (General Dental Services) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1975(d) shall be amended by the addition at the end of sub-paragraph (a) of the words "and who are not disentitled by virtue of the provisions of Article 61(2A) of the Order".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations make amendments to the Health and Personal Social Services (General Medical and Pharmaceutical Services) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973 and the Health and Personal Social Services (General Dental Services) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1975 consequential on amendments to the Health and Personal Social Services (Northern Ireland) Order 1972 by the European Communities (Medical, Dental and Nursing Professions) (Linguistic Knowledge) Order 1981. By virtue of that Order provision is made for practitioners who are nationals of, and qualified in, a member State to have their applications for inclusion in the medical or dental lists, refused if they do not have the necessary knowledge of English.
