ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Traffic Weight Restriction (Omagh) (No. 2) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1981

Made 8th September 1981

Coming into operation 19th October 1981

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 22(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf and being satisfied that the road and length of road specified in the schedule are unsuitable for use by certain classes of vehicles, hereby makes the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Traffic Weight Restriction (Omagh) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981 and shall come into operation on 19th October 1981.

Revocation

2. The Traffic Weight Restriction (Omagh) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981(b) is hereby revoked.

Prohibition

3. Subject to Article 4 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle the weight of which, whether laden or unladen, exceeds 2 tons to proceed on the road or length of road specified in the schedule.

Exemption

4. The prohibition in Article 3 shall not apply to vehicles requiring access to Arleston Road.

SCHEDULE

Arleston Road, Omagh.

That part of Irishtown Road, Omagh, which is carried by King James' Bridge over the Drumragh River.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This order revokes and re-enacts the provisions of the Traffic Weight Restriction (Omagh) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981 and prohibits vehicles exceeding 2 tons laden or unladen weight from using the road or length of road specified in the schedule.

Provision is made to exempt vehicles requiring access to Arleston Road.

Any person who acts in contravention of the order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £100.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the order will, in due course, be erected on the roads.

Medicines (Exemptions from Restrictions on the Retail Sale or Supply of Veterinary Drugs) (Amendment) Order 1981

This Order has been made by the Secretary of State concerned with health in England, the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with health and with agriculture in Scotland and in Wales, the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland, and the Department of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 57(1)(2) and 129(4) of the Medicines Act 1968.

In pursuance of paragraph 11 of Schedule 4 to that Act this Order has been registered as a Northern Ireland statutory rule under the Statutory Rules (Northern Ireland) Order 1979. It is printed in full in the volume of United Kingdom Statutory Instruments for 1981 and has been numbered 793 in that series.
