**Poultry Testing (Amendment) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1981***Made . . . . . 14th October 1981**Coming into operation . . . . . 25th November 1981**To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 3(3) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974*

The Department(a) of Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 8(1) and (3) of the Poultry Improvement Act (Northern Ireland) 1968(b) and of every other power enabling in in that behalf, after consultation as required by section 12(1) of the said Act and with the approval of the Department(a) of Finance as to charges, hereby makes the following Scheme:

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Scheme may be cited as the Poultry Testing (Amendment) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1981 and shall come into operation on 25th November 1981.

*Amendment of the Scheme of 1970*

2. In sub-paragraphs (a) and (b) of Article 6(1) of the Poultry Testing Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1970(c) for "£390"(d) there shall be substituted "£500".

*Revocation*

3. The Poultry Testing (Amendment) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1980(e) is hereby revoked.
