## ULSTER SAVINGS CERTIFICATES

Ulster Savings Certificates (Index Linked)  
(Amendment No. 3) Regulations 1981

*Made* . . . . . 15th October 1981

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 19th October 1981

The Department(a) of Finance in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 15(1) of the Exchequer and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1950(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following regulations:

1. These regulations may be cited as the Ulster Savings Certificates (Index Linked) (Amendment No. 3) Regulations 1981 and shall come into operation on 19th October 1981.

2. Schedule 3 to the Ulster Savings Certificates Regulations 1962(c) (which Schedule prescribes the maximum number of unit certificates which may be held) shall be further amended by substituting for paragraph (n) of the said Schedule the following paragraph:—

“(n) Five hundred in the case of certificates issued on or after 17th November 1980 (known as the Second Index Linked Issue)”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These regulations amend the Ulster Savings Certificates (Amendment) Regulations 1980 which introduced the Second Index Linked Issue. Their effect is to increase the maximum permitted holding of Ulster Savings Certificates of the Second Index Linked Issue from 300 units (£3,000) to 500 units (£5,000) as from 19th October 1981.
