ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

**One-Way Traffic (Ballynahinch) (No. 2) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1981***Made* 21st October 1981*Coming into operation* 23rd November 1981

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment (in this Order referred to as "the Department") is of the opinion that traffic should be prohibited from proceeding as described in Article 3;

AND WHEREAS notice has been published in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection has been received.

NOW THEREFORE the Department in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the One-Way Traffic (Ballynahinch) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981 and shall come into operation on 23rd November 1981.

Revocation

2. The One-Way Traffic (Ballynahinch) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981(b) is hereby revoked.

Prohibition

3. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on the road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule in a direction other than that specified in relation to that road in Column 2.

In the town of Ballynahinch, Co. Down. New entrance road from High Street to Car Park.	Westerly from High Street.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This order revokes and re-enacts the provisions of the One-Way Traffic (Ballynahinch) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981 and provides for a one-way traffic system on the new entrance road from High Street, Ballynahinch, to the car park.

Any person who acts in contravention of the order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £100.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the order will, in due course, be erected on the road.
