ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Traffic Weight Restriction (Altaguire Bridge) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1981

Made 9th February 1981

Coming into operation 1st April 1981

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a) and now vested in it(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf and being satisfied that the length of road described in article 2 is unsuitable for use by certain classes of vehicles, hereby makes the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Traffic Weight Restriction (Altaguire Bridge) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1981.

Prohibition

2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle the weight of which whether laden or unladen exceeds 5 tons to proceed on that part of Glendun Road (Route C106) in the townland of Beaghs and County of Antrim which is carried by the Altaguire Bridge over the Altaguire Burn.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

The effect of this order is to prohibit vehicles exceeding 5 tons laden or unladen weight from using that part of the Glendun Road (Route C106) in the townland of Beahs and County of Antrim which is carried by Altaguire Bridge over the Altaguire Burn.

Any person who acts in contravention of the order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £100.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the order have been erected on the road.
