## ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

**One-Way Traffic (Belfast-Newtownabbey) (Amendment No. 3) Order  
(Northern Ireland) 1981**

*Made* . . . . . 13th November 1981

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 21st December 1981

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment (in this Order referred to as "the Department") is of the opinion that traffic should proceed on the roads and in the direction specified in the schedule;

AND WHEREAS notice has been published in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following order:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the One-Way Traffic (Belfast-Newtownabbey) (Amendment No. 3) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981 and shall come into operation on 21st December 1981.

*Amendment*

2. The Schedule to the One-Way Traffic (Belfast-Newtownabbey) Order (Northern Ireland) 1980(b) shall be amended by the addition thereto of the items specified in the schedule.

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**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order amends the provisions of the One-Way Traffic (Belfast-Newtownabbey) Order (Northern Ireland) 1980.

The amendments provide for the introduction of one-way traffic in Elaine Street, Landseer Street and Pretoria Street, all in the City of Belfast.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the order will, in due course, be erected on the roads.
