## ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Prohibition of Traffic (Donaghadee) Order  
(Northern Ireland) 1981

*Made* . . . . . 24th November 1981

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 31st December 1981

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 22(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf and being satisfied that the road specified in Article 2 is unsuitable for use by vehicles, hereby makes the following order:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. This order may be cited as the Prohibition of Traffic (Donaghadee) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981 and shall come into operation on 31st December 1981.

*Prohibition*

2. Subject to Article 3 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on Hunter's Lane, Donaghadee.

*Exemption*

3. The prohibition in Article 2 shall not apply to the use of the said road in a north-easterly direction from High Street by vehicles being used either by the owners or occupiers of premises abutting on the said road or for the delivery or collection from such premises of goods of any kind, or in connection with public utility or emergency services.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order.)*

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicles from using Hunter's Lane, Donaghadee.

Provision is made to exempt vehicles being used by residents or being used in connection with the delivery or collection of goods or in connection with public utility or emergency services.

Any person who acts in contravention of the Order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £100.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will, in due course, be erected on the road.
