## ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

**One-way Traffic (Portaferry) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981**

*Made* . . . . . 20th March 1981

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 17th April 1981

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on it by article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. This order may be cited as the One-Way Traffic (Portaferry) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981 and shall come into operation on 17th April 1981.

*Prohibition*

2. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on the road or on the length of road specified in column 1 of the schedule in a direction other than that specified in relation to that road or length of road in column 2.

IN THE TOWN OF PORTAFERRY  Church Street  High Street from its junction with Ashmount Drive to its junction with The Square	Northerly from The Square  South-westerly from Ashmount Drive

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order.)*

This order provides for a one-way traffic system in the town of Portaferry.

Any person who acts in contravention of the order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £100.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will, in due course, be erected on the roads.
