Rainbow Trout Waters Byelaws (Northern Ireland) 1982

Made 14th April 1982
 Coming into operation 1st June 1982

The Fisheries Conservancy Board for Northern Ireland, in exercise of their powers under section 26 of the Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(a) and of every other power enabling them in that behalf, with the approval of the Department(b) of Agriculture hereby make the following Byelaws:

Citation and commencement

1. These Byelaws may be cited as the Rainbow Trout Waters Byelaws (Northern Ireland) 1982, and shall come into operation on 1st June 1982.

Designation of rainbow trout waters

2. The following waters are hereby designated for the purposes of Byelaw 51 of the Fisheries Consolidated, Amendment and Licence Duties Byelaws (Northern Ireland) 1969(c) (which stipulates that there shall be no close season for angling for rainbow trout in waters so designated):

Roughan Lake, Co Tyrone
 Henderson's Lake, Co. Londonderry
 Darkley Lake, Co. Armagh
 Lower Quoile Reservoir, Co. Antrim
 Mossley Mill Pond, Co. Antrim
 Tonaghmore Reservoir, Co. Down
 Warrenpoint Waterworks Reservoir, Co. Down
 Ballymartin Lough, Co. Down
 Ballymacashon Lough, Co. Down
 Kernan Lake, Co. Down
 Pepper's Lake, Co. Down
 Holybank Bleachworks Dam, Belfast.

Revocation

3. The Rainbow Trout Waters Byelaws (Northern Ireland) 1980(d) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Byelaws.)

These Byelaws designate a number of waters as rainbow trout waters for the purposes of Byelaw 51 of the Consolidated Byelaws of 1969 which provides that there shall be no close season for angling for rainbow trout in waters so designated. These Byelaws differ from the previous Byelaws in that Tullynawood Lake, Co. Armagh, is no longer designated as a rainbow trout water.
