JUDGMENTS (ENFORCEMENT)**The Judgment Enforcement (Administration Order Jurisdiction) Rules
(Northern Ireland) 1982***Made 8th April 1982**Coming into operation 1st June 1982**To be laid before Parliament*

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Articles 141(1) and 80(1)(b) of the Judgments Enforcement (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Rules:—

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules may be cited as the Judgment Enforcement (Administration Order Jurisdiction) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1982 and shall come into operation on 1st June 1982.

*Increase in financial limit of jurisdiction to make administration order
on application of debtor*

2. The sum of £5,000 is hereby prescribed, in lieu of the sum of £2,000 specified in Article 80(1)(b) of the Judgments Enforcement (Northern Ireland) Order 1981, as the limit on the total of unsecured debts of a debtor in respect of whom an administration order may be made.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Rules.)

These Rules increase the jurisdiction of the Enforcement of Judgments Office to make administration orders, by raising from £2,000 to £5,000 the limit on the total of unsecured debts of a debtor in respect of whom an order may be made.
