## EDUCATION

Colleges of Education Salaries (Amendment) Regulations  
(Northern Ireland) 1982

Made . . . . . 4th June 1982

Coming into operation . . . . . 30th June 1982

The Department(a) of Education in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 57(1), (2) and (4) and 125(1) of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(b) and section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962(c) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

*Citation and commencement*

1. These regulations may be cited as the Colleges of Education Salaries (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1982 and shall come into operation on 30th June 1982 and shall have effect on and from 1st April 1982.

*Amendment of principal regulations*

2. The Colleges of Education Salaries Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981(d) are hereby amended in accordance with the following provisions of these regulations and references in these regulations to a numbered regulation or schedule are references to the regulation or schedule so numbered in those regulations.

*Substitutions*

3.—(1) In Regulation 10(1) and (2) (allowances for head of department) for “£1,167” and “£1,026” there shall be substituted “£1,224” and “£1,077” respectively.

(2) In Regulation 11 (allowances for principal lecturer) for “1981” where it occurs and “7½%” there shall be substituted “1982” and “5%” respectively.

(3) In paragraphs 1, 7 and 8 of Schedule I for the existing tables of salary scales there shall be substituted the respective tables of salary scales set out in the Schedule.

(4) In Schedule II (Entry to Scales of Salaries) for “1981” in all places where it occurs there shall be substituted “1982”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These regulations amend the Colleges of Education Salaries Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981 by introducing with effect from 1st April 1982 revised scales and ranges of salaries for lecturers, vice-principals and principals in the colleges of education.

The regulations also provide for increased rates of allowances in certain cases with effect from 1st April 1982.

Where the regulations have retrospective effect this is by virtue of section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962.
