The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 105(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Bye-laws:—

Citation and commencement

1. These Bye-laws may be cited as the Off-Street Parking (Amendment No. 2) Bye-laws (Northern Ireland) 1982 and shall come into operation on 26th July 1982.

Bye-laws amended

2. The Off-Street Parking Bye-laws (Northern Ireland) 1976(b) shall be amended by the addition to Schedule 1 Part I of the car park in the Schedule.
