The Department of Manpower Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 1 of the Departments (No. 2) (Northern Ireland) Order 1982(a) and paragraph 2(1) and (2) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974(b), hereby makes the following Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Departments (No. 2) (1982 Order) (Commencement) Order (Northern Ireland) 1982.

2. The Departments (No. 2) (Northern Ireland) Order 1982 shall come into operation on 6th September 1982.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings into operation on 6th September 1982 the Departments (No. 2) (Northern Ireland) Order 1982 which renames the Department of Manpower Services as the Department of Economic Development and transfers to that Department the functions of the Department of Commerce which it dissolves.

The whole of the Departments (No. 2) (Northern Ireland) Order is brought into effect by this Commencement Order.
