**One-Way Traffic (Belfast-Newtownabbey) Order (Amendment)  
(Northern Ireland) 1982**

*Made* . . . . . 10th August 1982

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 20th September 1982

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment (in this Order referred to as "the Department") has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following order:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the One-Way Traffic (Belfast-Newtownabbey) Order (Amendment) (Northern Ireland) 1982 and shall come into operation on 20th September 1982.

*Amendment*

2. The One-Way Traffic (Belfast-Newtownabbey) Order (Northern Ireland) 1982(b) shall be amended by the deletion from Schedule 2 of the item relating to Townhall Street, Belfast.
