## SOCIAL SECURITY

**The Social Security (Overlapping Benefits) (Amendment) Regulations  
(Northern Ireland) 1982**

*Made* . . . . . 20th August 1982

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 14th September 1982

The Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 85 of the Social Security (Northern Ireland) Act 1975(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations which correspond to provision contained in regulations made by the Secretary of State for Social Services in relation to Great Britain and which accordingly, by virtue of section 10(2) of, and paragraph 21 of Schedule 3 to, the Social Security Act 1980(b) are not subject to the requirement of section 10(1) of that Act for prior reference to the Social Security Advisory Committee:

*Citation, commencement and interpretation*

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Overlapping Benefits) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1982 and shall come into operation on 14th September 1982.

(2) In these regulations “the principal regulations” means the Social Security (Overlapping Benefits) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1979(c).

*Amendment of regulation 10 of the principal regulations*

2. Paragraph (1) of regulation 10 of the principal regulations (adjustment of dependency benefit where certain personal benefit is payable) shall be further amended by substituting a semi-colon for the comma in sub-paragraph (g) and inserting after sub-paragraph (g) the following sub-paragraph—

“(h) a weekly allowance pursuant to arrangements made by the Department of Economic Development(d) under section 1(1) of the Employment and Training Act (Northern Ireland) 1950(e) for the purpose of the Enterprise Allowance Scheme.”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These regulations further amend regulation 10 of the Social Security (Overlapping Benefits) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1979 by adding an allowance payable by virtue of arrangements made by the Department of Economic Development under the Enterprise Allowance Scheme to the categories of personal benefit payable to the dependant by reference to which a dependency benefit payable for the same period is required to be reduced.
