BUILDING SOCIETIES**Building Societies (Special Advances) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1982***Made 17th September 1982**Coming into operation 8th November 1982**To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 3(3) of Schedule 1
to the Northern Ireland Act 1974*

The Registrar, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 21(4) and (5) of the Building Societies Act (Northern Ireland) 1967(a) and of every other power enabling him in that behalf, with the consent of the Department of Economic Development(b), hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Building Societies (Special Advances) Order (Northern Ireland) 1982 and shall come into operation on 8th November 1982.

Special advances

2. The sum prescribed under section 21(4) of the Building Societies Act (Northern Ireland) 1967 shall, in relation to advances made by building societies in any financial year beginning on or after the date of the coming into operation of this Order, be sixty thousand pounds.

Revocation

3. The Building Societies (Special Advances) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981(c) is hereby revoked but not so as to affect its operation in relation to advances made by a building society in its financial year beginning before and current at the date of the coming into operation of this Order.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order enables a building society, in relation to any advances made in any financial year beginning on or after the date of the coming into operation of the Order, to advance to any individual up to £60,000 instead of £37,500 without the advance being treated as a special advance under the Building Societies Act (Northern Ireland) 1967. It supersedes the Building Societies (Special Advances) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981.
