#### Citation

1. This order may be cited as the Forfeiture (1982 Order) (Commencement) Order (Northern Ireland) 1982.

2. The appointed day for the purposes of Article 6 of the Forfeiture (Northern Ireland) Order 1982 (Social Security Commissioner to decide whether forfeiture rule applies in relation to right to benefits and advantages under certain legislation relating to social security and pensions) is 31st December 1982.
