ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Roads (Speed Limit) (No. 6) Order (Northern Ireland) 1982

Made 9th December 1982

Coming into operation 5th January 1983

To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 3(3) of Schedule 1
to the Northern Ireland Act 1974

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 50(4) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Roads (Speed Limit) (No. 6) Order (Northern Ireland) 1982 and shall come into operation on 5th January 1983.

Revocation

2. Item 20 of the Fifth Schedule to the Roads (Speed Limit) Order (Northern Ireland) 1973(b).

Increase of speed limit

3. In relation to the length of road specified in the Schedule the rate of speed fixed by Article 50(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 shall be increased to forty miles per hour.

SCHEDULE

Old Dundonald Road, Route C265 from a point approximately 70 yards (64 metres) west of the East Link Road to a point approximately 800 yards (732 metres) west of this junction.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order reduces the length of the road specified in the Schedule to which a 40 miles per hour speed limit applies, thus increasing the length to which a 30 miles per hour speed limit applies.
