## EDUCATION

**Education and Library Boards (Officers) (Amendment) Regulations  
(Northern Ireland) 1982**

*Made* . . . . . 22nd December 1982

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 14th February 1983

The Department(a) of Education, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 71(5) and 125(1) of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

*Citation and commencement*

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Education and Library Boards (Officers) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1982 and shall come into operation on 14th February 1983.

*Amendment of the Education and Library Boards (Officers) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1980*

2. In paragraph (1) of Regulation 3 of the Education and Library Boards (Officers) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1980(c) for “£7,000” there shall be substituted “£9,200”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations.)*

The Education and Library Boards (Officers) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1980 provide that education and library board officers to whom a salary scale applies which carries a maximum remuneration of £7,000 a year or more shall not be removed from office, nor shall their salaries or remuneration be fixed or altered, without the approval of the Department of Education.

These regulations amend the 1980 Regulations by raising the salary scale maximum figure from £7,000 a year or more to £9,200 a year or more.
